

# What are your rights?

The NDIS was created to make sure every person with a disability has the right to make and control decisions about their own lives. The *United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities* main purpose is to **promote, protect and ensure the full and equal enjoyment of all human rights and freedoms by all people with disabilities.**

## Confidentiality

**RESPECT** for personal information is important for all participants

**INFORMATION** that is written or spoken about you should be kept private

**PRIVATE** **INFORMATION** of others should not be spoken or

**MEETINGS** of staff may discuss your information in confidence

**INCLUSION** You should always be told about meetings of staff

**PERMISSION** You should be asked whether you want information shared

**STORAGE** Any personal information kept is stored safely

**REVIEW** You can review your information at any time
